Omaha Summer Arts Festival (OSAF) – Chalk Art

About OSAF:

OSAF is one of Douglas County's elite signature events <u>attracting an estimated 75,000 people each year</u>. OSAF is presented free to the community and offers a diverse recreation and entertainment opportunity, by providing a showcase for our community – highlighting the best that Douglas County can offer to its residents and out-of-town visitors alike.

Cultural diversity is at the core of the Omaha Summer Arts Festival – from our musical series, "Voices of the World," featuring local, regional, and national performers, to our Artists' Market which has offered the artwork of more than 135 local, national, and international artists representing 35 states, Mexico and Canada.

OSAF offers a unique blend of enriching arts and entertainment programs free of charge. Over the past 49 years, the Omaha Summer Arts Festival has developed into a regional draw – regularly attracting visitors from an area as large as 150 miles in radius outside of Douglas County.

OSAF Chalk Art: (5-6 Artists will be chosen to participate)

- Each artist is asked to submit a brief description of the proposed chalk drawing.
 - All artworks must be appropriate for public and family viewing.
- Each artist will be provided a 7'x13' rectangle.
 - \circ Art should cover at least 6'x8' from the center of this rectangle and extend out.
 - If space allows, artists may use an adjacent square for self-promotion of your art.
 - Promote your website, social media, etc.
 - This space may not be used to promote any other business, sponsor or artist.
- Artists will be provided:

- o A \$250 stipend
 - Two \$15 OSAF Food Vouchers
 - Vouchers must be used during festival hours at OSAF food booths/trucks.
 - No cashback is given.
 - If you spend more than \$15 at a food booth/truck you are responsible for paying the difference.
- o 2023 OSAF T-shirt
- One (1) starter set of 24 soft pastels.
 - Only non-oil based soft chalk/pastels are permitted.
- Artists should work during festival hours on Friday and Saturday between 10:00am-6:00pm.
 - Art should be complete by Saturday evening and available for viewing on Sunday.
 - Artists should be onsite a minimum of 5 hours each day (Friday & Saturday, June 9-10).
