

2023 Omaha Summer Arts Festival ArtSeen

Rules & Regulations for Participation

- 1) Galleries, organizations, or artist collaborations in Omaha metropolitan area.
- 2) Limited number of spaces are available throughout the Festival all are 10' x 20' with a tent provided.
- 3) Three ways to participate:
 - a. Provide an interactive art activity for the public and sell artwork all three days of the Festival (demonstrations are encouraged in conjunction with an interactive public art project) booth fee waived.
 - b. Provide continuous demonstrations and sell artwork all three days of the Festival (with no interactive public art project) booth fee is \$400.
 - c. Provide a public art project and/or demonstrating artists at the Festival but will NOT sell artwork booth fee waived.
- 4) All work must be the original work of the artist(s) associated with your group. Only work of artists from your group may be sold or displayed
- 5) If you have elected to participate as a selling group, all artwork on display must be available for sale.
- 6) Artwork from any medium can be displayed and/or sold.
- 7) No artwork from molds, kits or other commercial methods is allowed.
- 8) Limited edition prints are accepted in editions of 500 or less, provided each is individually signed and numbered. All developing and printing of photographs must be done from the artist's original negative and under the artist's direct supervision.
- 9) Exhibitors may not sell food, beverages, or promotional items (t-shirts, postcards, calendars, etc.) at the Festival.
- 10) Promotion of other art shows, including display of posters or other publicity is not allowed.
- 11) Business cards, fliers, and/or brochures are welcome.
- 12) The Omaha Summer Arts Festival will provide some signage for each booth. The Festival encourages you to professionally decorate and promote your gallery space with unique design, professionally prepared signs or banners.
