STREET CLOSURES PLANNED, BUT FREE PARKING STILL AVAILABLE AT 2023 OSAF
Aksarben Village Roads Closed Off For 49th Annual Omaha Summer Arts Festival

(OMAHA, Nebr.) June 6, 2023 – To accommodate the 49th annual Omaha Summer Arts Festival, which will be held June 9-11 in Aksarben Village, the following streets will be closed from 6 a.m. Thursday, June 8 until 11:59 p.m. Sunday, June 11:

- 67th Street from Center Street to Shirley Street
- Mercy Road from 67th Street to Aksarben Drive
- Frances Street from 64th to 67th Streets
- Frances Street from 67th Street to Aksarben Drive

Metro bus riders are encouraged to call 402-341-0800 for updated information on rerouted bus lines.

Parking Options in Aksarben Village

There is ample FREE parking available in Aksarben Village for those attending the Omaha Summer Arts Festival. Festivalgoers can find parking in the following garages:

- Aksarben Village Zone 3 parking garage – 6464 Marinda Street, access from 64th Street (free parking 24 hours, 7 days a week)
- Aksarben Village Zone 5 parking garage – 6729 Frances Street, access from Aksarben Drive (free parking 24 hours, 7 days a week)
- Aksarben Village Zone 6 parking garage – 6460 Frances Street, access from Shirley Street (free parking 24 hours, 7 days a week)
- Blue Cross Blue Shield parking garage – 6718 Frances Street (free parking after 4 p.m. Monday through Friday, and all day Saturday and Sunday)

The Omaha Farmers Market will relocate its Sunday Market on June 11 to Baxter Arena Lot 26.
